## TECH TALK

### PROTECT YOUR OUTDOOR EXTENSION CORDS

Some of us New Englanders have to store their Model A's in a separate building during the winter. In order to get temporary electrical power to out-building in a safe weather-proof manner, Tony Zeoli's sons, came up with an ingenious way to get the job done.

Some things needed:

½" irrigation  
piping



extension  
cord



cotton  
ball



nylon  
line



Vaseline

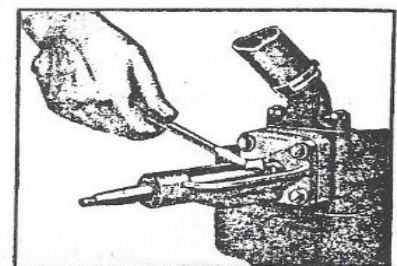


vacuum  
cleaner

- Step 1. Fasten a cotton ball to the end of nylon line.
- Step 2. Put cotton ball in one end of the irrigation tubing
- Step 3. Attach the vacuum cleaner tightly to the other end of the irrigation tubing
- Step 4. Apply Vaseline to gloved hand feeding the nylon string
- Step 5. Turn on the vacuum and suck the cotton ball and nylon line through to the other end.  
This can be done with the tubing still coiled.
- Step 6. Straighten out the tubing with a person on each end.
- Step 7. Cut off a plug on an end of the extension cord,
- Step 8. Fasten the nylon line to the "cut-off" end of the extension cord.
- Step 9. Pull the extension cord through the ½" irrigation tubing.
- Step 10. Refasten the cut off plug to the extension cord.

Packing is used in forming a water tight connection around the water pump shaft. Should a leak develop in the water pump lubricate the water pump shaft first then tighten the packing nut. Modern type water resistant grease may be used. Do not tighten the packing nut more than is necessary to stop the leak.

Replacement water pump packing if required is available for less than \$ 1.00.

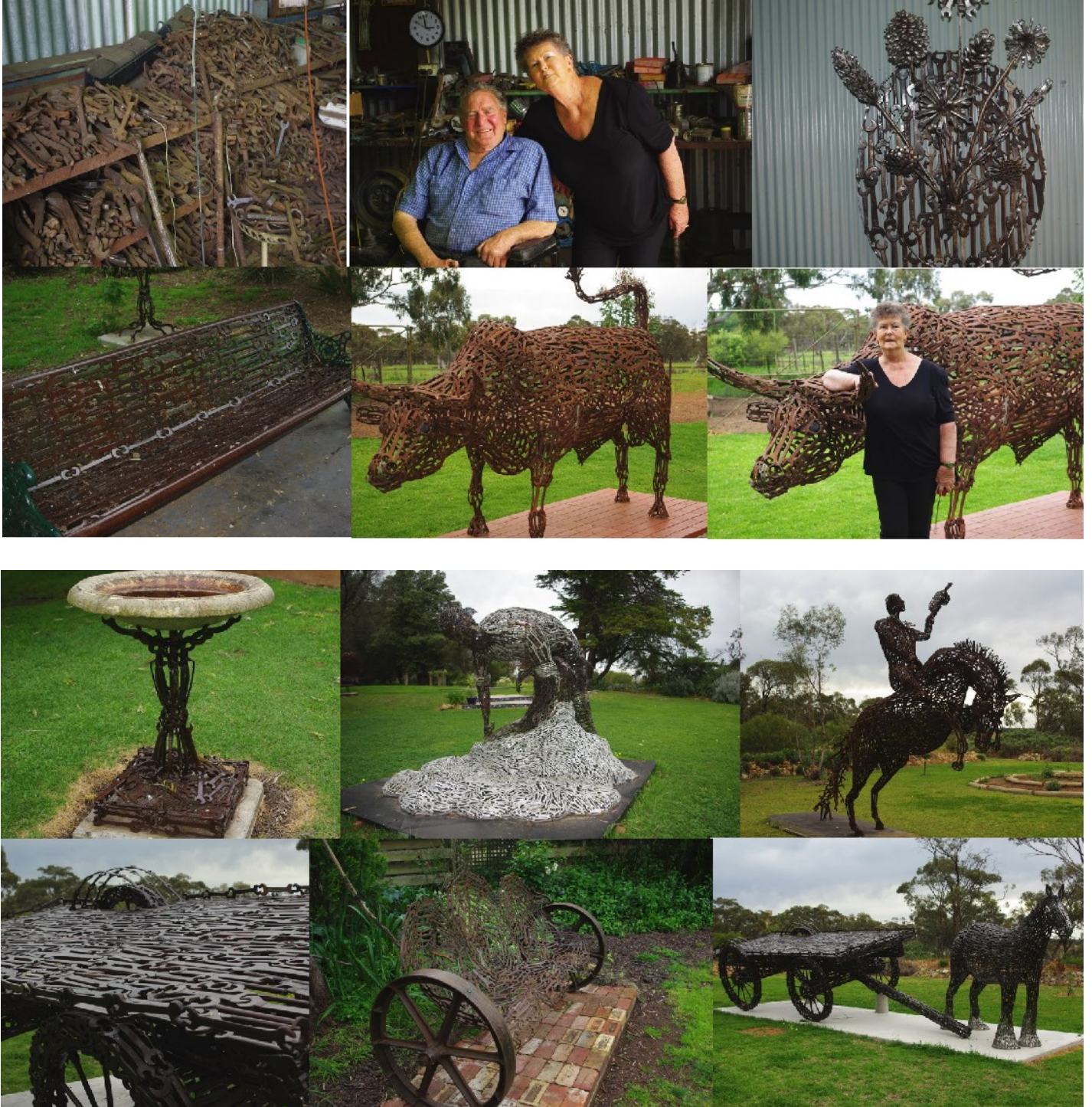


Tightening Water Pump Shaft

EDITOR SAYS

## *73,000 Miles is only a Start*

SOME weeks ago we published an account of a Ford that had been driven 73,000 miles in less than a year by three mail carriers in Iowa.

The article created much comment and brought many letters telling of the unusual reliability, economy and long life of the Ford. Here is an interesting letter from the editor of a newspaper in Kansas:

"In one of your recent advertisements in weekly newspapers you tell of a Ford that has been driven 73,000 miles in less than a year.

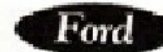

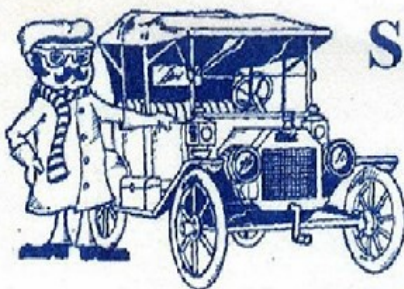

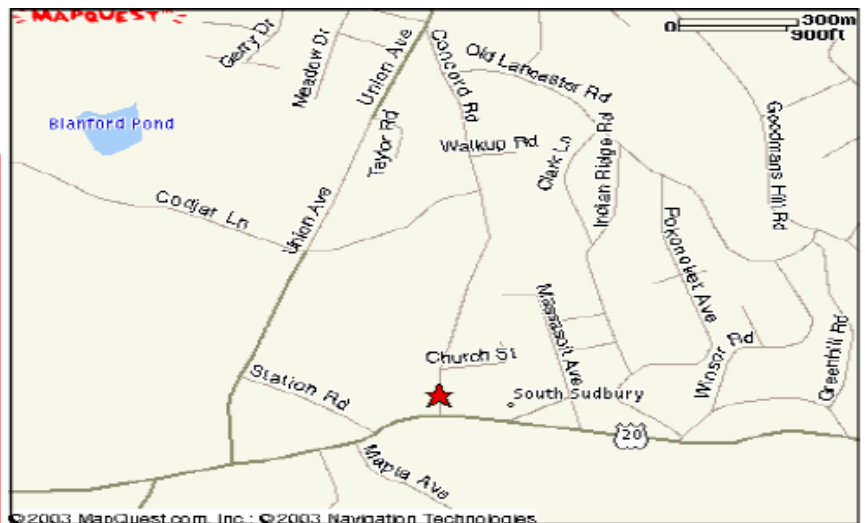
