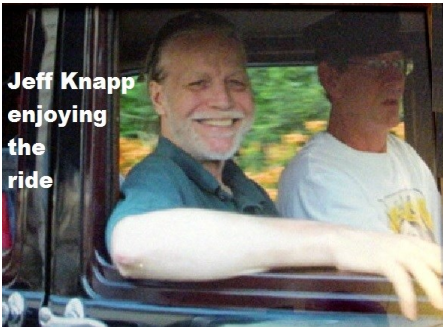






### A Model A Story by Bob Mangan

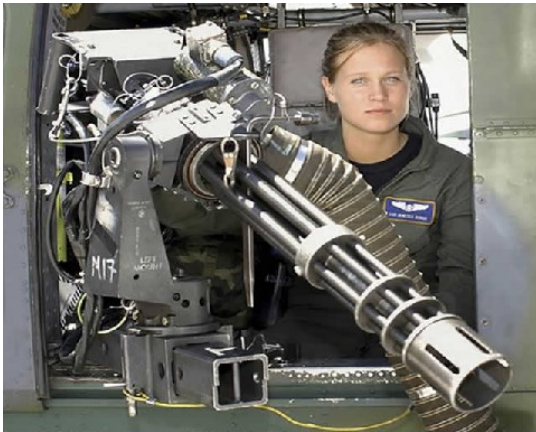

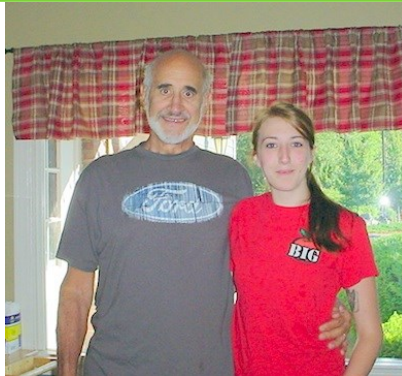
### The Real Miss America
